EU TWINNING PROJECT CLOSING CONFERENCE

Closing conference of the EU-funded Twinning project "Support to the State Social Protection Fund on the introduction of funded element within the insurance – pension system, establishment of non - state pension funds and development of legal framework for regulating their activity" will be on the 28th of October, 2015. The closing event will be followed by the Workshop on the draft laws on Funded part of Labour pensions and on Private pension funds.
