Statistics Norwegian Population

> 5.3 millions inhabitants

- > Population age 80+: 4,5 %
- > in 2100 probably 11-12 %

> 15 % disabled





Milestones universal design in Norway

- > Mid 1990s: the conscept adopted from USA
- > Translated to «Universell utforming»
- > 1997: Group of experts engaged
- > 2004: First action plan (2004-2008)





Milestones in universal design in Norway


- > 2007: Law: Universal Design Claim in Public Procurements
- > 2009: Anti-Discrimination and Accessibility Act and revised Planning and Building Act
- > 2009: Second action plan (2009-2013)
- > 2010: Policy area moved from health to equality
- > 2013: Regulation on universal design of ICT (web & automats)






Milestones universal design in Norway

- > 2013: Ratification of CRPD
- > 2015: Third action plan (2015-2019)
- > 2016: Regulation on ICT extension: ICT in education
- > 2018: The Equality and Anti-Discrimination Act

- > The Norwegian government's vision is a society where everyone can participate
- > The government intend to continue the work for a universal designed society
- > Focus on universal design in the digital society and for all primary schools
- > Increase thee number of persons with disabilities working
